Igoumenitsa, Preveza and other Greek cities. A regular ferry service from Igoumenitsa to the ports of Italy connects Ioannina with Western Europe. A relevant service also links the city with Corfu. The city of Ioannina has an airport at a distance of 4 km. from the city center and 10 km. from the campus, with daily flights to Athens. The campus is located at a 6 km. distance from the city centre and access is possible: By urban bus that runs every 10 mins from the city centre; By taxi (costs around €5); By car (10 min.)















Directions from Airport
